His two principal fields of study are the history of American higher education and research universities. He is also an editor of *The Future of the American Public Research University* (2007). Additionally, a study of contemporary research universities and the market forces that have shaped them was published by Stanford University Press in 2004, *Knowledge and Money: Research Universities and the Paradox of the Marketplace*.
